English

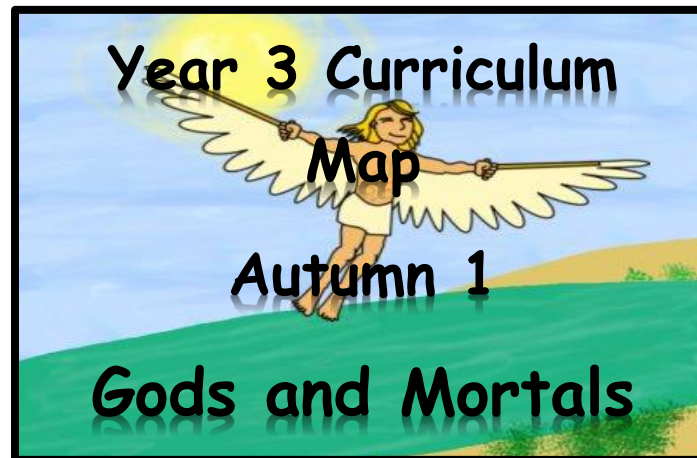
We will be listening, reading and discussing a variety of Greek myths, stories and legends.
