raise **£500** which will fund a teacher and all books and supplies. The school relies on charity fundraising to stay open and provide the village children with a primary education.

#### Moulton Allotments – Junior Growers Club

Moulton Allotments have launched the Junior Growers Club which will operate on a designated allotment plot between April and July each year.

We are looking to recruit a group of 10 young people aged between 5 and 11 years of age who will attend for around 1 hour on alternate Saturday mornings starting at 10am. Each member will have their own raised bed, and will grow a small range of vegetable crops which they can take home when they have been harvested. These sessions will be supervised by experienced allotment holders, led by a former senior manager from Moulton College who has 35 years experience of teaching land based subjects, **but we would also need a parent or responsible adult to work with each young person.** The cost for each member is £10 and this will cover the cost of all seeds, fertiliser, compost, modules, labels etc and a drink which will be provided at the end of each session.

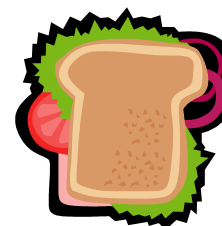


Self Service from the Lunch Trolley
