Years 3, 4, 5 & 6 only

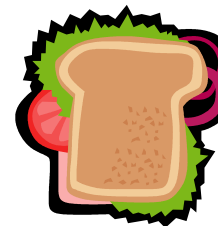


Self Service from the Lunch Trolley
