It is very clear that you believe we are good at promoting good behaviour and that children feel safe. We will always do our best to make sure these values are a school priority at all times.

We are very proud of our staff and it clear from the survey that you find them approachable, supportive and able to teach to a high standard.

Due to your response we are able to identify the areas for concern and deal with these concerns in an appropriate manner.

One area of concern surrounds communication of events and your child's targets. Firstly, we are re-designing the school website to make it more informative and user friendly. We are hoping that the introduction of half-yearly reports will help you understand your child's targets.

A large number of you filled out the homework survey sent out and this is in the process of being analysed and several new ideas are being formulated to address homework concerns raised by the survey.

One area of concern was school meals and that is being addressed at the highest level.

Another area raised was how we challenge the more able children. This has been a key focus for our all our staff over the past months as is ensuring that all children, whatever their ability, make good progress.
